- 2240 presentations
 - 1755 triage
 - 485 roofless
- 852 open cases
- 500 preventions
- 191 acceptances

2013 – 2014

- 2790 presentations
 - 2239 triage
 - 540 roofless
- 1106 open cases
- 767 preventions
- 177 acceptances



Funding

- £48,000 from the Regional Homelessness Group for Making Every Adult Matter (MEAM) pilot
- £81,000 between North and South Tyneside from the Regional Homelessness Group for a two year Outreach and Engagement service
- £1.9m regionally through the Fair Chance Fund
- £203,000 between North and South Tyneside and Sunderland through the Help for Single Homeless Fund



Funding

- **Depaul UK** secured additional HCA funding to remodel Compass project from 8 to 14 en-suite bedrooms
- **Home Group** secured HCA funding (Affordable Homes Programme 2015 – 2018) to purchase properties for ex -offenders



New schemes

- **YMCA:** part conversion of North Shields building to provide 15 x 1 bedroom flats with on site support for single young people
- **YMCA:** purchase of a community house for young singles with a low level offending history
- **Changing Lives:** secured lease of a property from Square Build Trust. Conversion work underway to provide 5 self contained flats/bedsits with support.
